Tres Pescado Slam Tournament

The “Cast Off” poster on the previous page can be used to promote a “Cast Off” event in your area.

White space was intentionally made available on the right of the tournament graphics to place you organizations logo or other material.

Local businesses can help the team compete in Belize. Sponsor fishing shirts sporting the businesses’ logos will be seen by international anglers.

The following is a typical “Cast Off” event rules:

Typical Rules for Fly Casting “Cast Off” Competitions

Rods, Reels and Lines

All casting will be done with X wt rods, lines and reels, provided by the event organizer. Rods will be available for inspection one hour prior to the start of the event.

Scoring

1. The ruling of the event director(s) or their appointees will be final.
2. Casting will take place rain or shine and will be delayed only for electrical storms.
3. Each caster will cast in the designated event area.
4. Each competitor will have two minutes to warm up prior to casting.
5. Each competitor will have three minutes to complete 3 casts.
6. Each competitor will have 15 seconds and one cast to complete the bonus target.
7. Leaders will be maintained at X.X feet with Xx tippet.
8. Competition fly will be a #X bright yellow fly, with the hook removed.
9. Competitors will be scored by the final resting place of the fly.
10. If the fly touches the forward casting area, it will be scored as a cast at the target.
11. Each competitor will get three casts at each of the accuracy targets.
12. If the fly, leader or fly line comes in contact with the obstacle while casting at the obstacle target, it will be scored a zero.
13. Each competitor will have three minutes to complete the distance casting part of the event.
14. Each competitor will be allowed three attempts at the distance cast.
15. Each competitor’s farthest distance cast will be scored.
16. Distance cast will be measured to the nearest inch.

17. Accuracy cast will be scored:
outside of the outer ring worth zero points
inside outer ring worth 100 points
inside middle ring worth 200 points
inside inner ring worth 300 points
bonus target worth 500 points

18. Competitors are not allowed to drag their line while it is on the course. Any and all adjustments must be made in the air.

19. Competitors may dump their cast to the ground behind them without penalty.

20. Highest combined scores of distance, accuracy and bonus target will be ruled the winner of casting competition.

The above “Cast Off” typical rules illustrate the minimum requirements to hold a “Cast Off” for accuracy and distance. However, there are many variations of the event including the type of location. A park setting with grass can be just as easy as using a casting pond.

Be inventive and please have your team members representing your area tells about your local event.

Should you have other members or casters wishing to come during the tournament, please be advised that most every guide will be booked during the tournament.
