Tres Pescado Slam Tournament Team Information

I. Creating a Team.

Teams for the 2010 Tres Pescados Slam Tournament consist of no more than 2 fly fishers and 1 guide for the Pro Division and no more than 2 fly fishers without a guide for the amateur division.

Fielding a team can be a fun event for local fly shops, sporting goods outlets, fly fishing clubs, and other organizations. Hosting a “Cast Off” or other similar events in your local town whereby 2 person fly fishers compete for the chance to attend the Tres Pescado Slam Tournament here in Belize can not only be fun but profitable for your organization.

Holding a “Cast Off” event is rather simple with an elimination event where entries assemble at the local casting ponds, park, or other venue where 200 feet of casting area is available and compete for distance or accuracy. Providing team sponsorship via donations, entry fees, or other means, will help your organization as well as defray the costs of sending the team to compete in Belize.

Need help in setting up a “Cast Off”? Contact us and we’ll email detailed steps and promotional material that you can personalize and print out.

A “Cast Off” event can bring your local fly casters into your fly shop. We have a Tres Pescado Slam Tournament “Cast Off” poster in .pdf format available on this site for download and printing on your computer’s printer. You simply fill in the dates and times. To register your team, please continue on in this packet. Payments must be made using the payment information detailed in this packet.

II. Early Registration and Banquets.

Due to the need for early notification and locking in the number of meals at the Caster’s Meeting banquet and the closing Caster’s Banquet, early registration is requested and will lock in your dinner seat at each of these 2 events. Early registration ends on July 15th, 2010. Late registration will be open until the close of the Caster’s Meeting Wednesday August 11, 2010. Late registration fees are higher and if seats can still be added you’ll be seated at the event’s closing Caster’s Banquet, but no guarantee of seating and/or meal(s) will be given for late registration.

Please enter early and lock in your spot for the tournament banquets.

II. Team Details and Registration Form.

The Tres Pescados Slam Tournament (TPST) is a 3 day event running from Thursday, August 12th through Saturday, August 14th. The tournament will concentrate on Ambergris Caye's saltwater fly fishing grand slam population and use only proper catch and release methods for all fish caught in this tournament.

The Tournament shall be governed by the fly fishing rules of the International Game Fish Association ("IGFA Rules") and these TPST Rules, as amended from time to time. In the rare instances when the TPST Rules may conflict with the IGFA Rules, the TPST Rules shall supersede the IGFA Rules. It is the responsibility of each fly fisher and guide to know the [IGFA Fly Fishing Rules](#) and the TPST Rules.

The TPST contestants will fish for all three (3) saltwater fly fishing grand slam fish during each of the three (3) days of the tournament. Points will be accrued with each inch of fish caught, measured and photographed. Each species will have its own points with total slam points consisting of the combined total of each species points. All fish sighted, caught and released will be counted. Caught fish will be measured and photographed for entry into the tourney. The team ID number and tape measure must be clearly visible in all photos entered into tournament.

All areas in and around Ambergris Caye are open to fish, however all teams must be present at the judges station for the start and finish of each day they are entered to fish.

The teams will consist of no more than two (2) fly fishers per boat and one (1) guide for each pro team and no more than two (2) fly fishers for each local amateur team. The tourney will be a 3 day event with a casting competition, poling contest and many other activities for the whole family all centered in and around the San Pedro Central Park.

To enter the tournament you'll need to register and if you're planning on being one of the pro teams you'll want to register early as there is a limited number of available fly fishing guides here on the island. The contestant team is responsible for obtaining and paying his or her guide. A list of available guides can be found on the **guides listing** page at <http://www.tres-pescado-tournament.org> .

Early registration will be open until July 15th, 2010. Late registration will be open until the end of the Caster's Meeting Wednesday August 11, 2010. Late registration fees are \$150BZ per fly fisher and \$400 BZ for each Pro Guide Boat.

At least one team member, anglers or guide, must attend the Casters Meeting banquet on Wednesday evening August 11th, 2010 to receive the latest tournament updates and catch and release packet. Caster Meeting banquet venue TBD - all teams will be notified of venue via email.

Total early entry fee (\$500 BZ – no discount for less than 2 anglers competing) includes 3 Caster Meeting banquet tickets and 3 Caster's Banquet tickets. Additional tickets for either event can be purchased with team members and sponsors having first chance at available seats.
